## HEALTH AND SAFETY

### ANIMALS

Dangerous animals can be found throughout the Kimberley. If seen, do not intimidate. Withdraw and alert others in the area.

### SLIPS AND FALLS

Sections along the area are rocky and challenging. Take care negotiating large rocks, creek beds, water and sandy sections. By wearing suitable footwear, obeying your guide and signs and employing common sense, you will minimise the chance of injury.

### HEAT ILLNESS

Drink water, wear a hat and rest in shade to minimise heat problems.

## TAKE WITH YOU

- **Sturdy and enclosed footwear (thongs are not suitable)**
- **Camera,**
- **Binoculars**
- **Swimming attire, towel, sunscreen**
- **Water, Snacks**
- **Wide brim hat**
- **A small backpack to carry any loose items**

Home Valley Station is operating a full-day tour inspired by the old Barclay stock route to Wyndham.

This tour has been researched and put together by our Indigenous trainees - so we are very proud of it!

The tour has been named Chimoolie Calling after the local Indigenous people's name for the area which was the last stop before Wyndham on the old stock route.

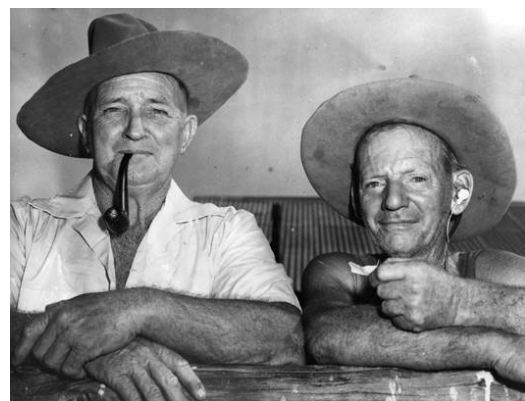
The area is a large mass of land about 5km out of Wyndham which runs from the base of Bastion Point back towards the Carlton Ranges.

It is here - after having driven cattle up via the Karunjie Track - that stockmen would water the cattle before moving on to the abattoir at Wyndham.

### PLEASE HELP US PROTECT OUR ENVIRONMENT

Don't litter. Please take all your rubbish with you. This includes cigarette butts, fruit peel and toilet paper.

It is against the law to disturb or destroy the local flora and fauna. Never touch or tamper with Rock Art and/or Artifacts.



## USEFUL INFORMATION

Chimoolie Calling circumnavigates the Cockburn Range via 4WD, lead by an HV8 Tour Guide and has many highlights, including:

Pentecost River, Cockburn Range, The Prison Tree on the King River Road, Five Rivers Lookout, Wetland bird sanctuary Parry Lagoon Nature Reserve and The Grotto.

Optional extra - guests may opt to visit the Wyndham Crocodile Farm. Own expense, simply ask your guide!
