HEALTH AND SAFETY

ANIMALS

Dangerous animals can be found throughout the Kimberley. If seen, do not intimidate. Withdraw and alert others in the area.

SLIPS AND FALLS

Sections along the area are rocky and challenging. Take care negotiating large rocks, creek beds, water and sandy sections. By wearing suitable footwear, obeying your guide and signs and employing common sense, you will minimise the chance of injury.

HEAT ILLNESS

Drink water, wear a hat and rest in shade to minimise heat problems.

TAKE WITH YOU

- **Jeans or long durable pants**
- **Sturdy boots or enclosed footwear (thongs and open shoes are not suitable)**
- **Camera**
- **Sunscreen**
- **Own full or half chaps if available**

TRAIL FACT SHEET - GUIDED - 2.5 HOURS

Home Valley has a wide range of horses to suit the wide range of visitors we have to our stables. Daily trail rides leave the Homestead for the Pentecost River, under the safe and experienced guidance of our station stockmen and women. This is a great morning or afternoon activity offering guests an authentic Kimberley cattle station experience while providing an opportunity to quietly sneak up on the herd and surrounding wildlife. The terrain includes savannah plains, rocky ridgelines and pristine river banks while almost always looking across to the spectacular Cockburn Range.

The suggested route is marked to guide you safely to the attractions and back. Please follow the markers and keep to the route at all times. Moving off the route will damage this sensitive environment.



USEFUL INFORMATION

Guests meet at the reception desk before each departure and are escorted to the stables. Helmets and basic tuition is provided in the Stable's Round Yard prior to departure. The ride itself is generally conducted at a walking pace and each group per individual will be assessed and cared for throughout the tour at which time your guide will determine if the group may be confident and able to trot or canter during certain sections of the journey. This tour is truly spectacular!
